Overview

Cromwell Abbey provides 2, 3 & 4 bedroom homes in Ramsey. Offering village lifestyle within this small market town of Ramsey with easy access to the larger towns of Huntingdon and St Ives and the cities of Peterborough and Cambridge.

This development consists of 100 homes.

Site activity

- Construction is progressing in accordance with the build route, with approximately 65% of the development built complete.
- 100% of the service mains is laid and live.
- Live water discharge is in place.
- Public open space is subject to be completed in 2025.
- First pond is open to the public and the 2nd pond will be opened in April 2025, this includes the footpaths to the pond.
- Public open space is expected to be completed in 2025

Timeline

- First completions took place in Spring 2024 with over 55% of homes now moved into.
- Show home is available at this development The Aspen
- View home is available at this development The Cypress
- Our Sales Centre is open and located next to the show homes.
