

We wanted to provide you with an update on the development and what you can expect from us over the coming months.

Overview

Summary of what's being built:

- 300 Homes. 75 of which are affordable
- Attenuation basins
- Photovoltaic panels and EV charging
- New sub station
- New pumping station

Site activity

- 75 homes currently in construction
- Moving towards completion of phase 1 Mid-August 24*
- Of the homes currently under construction we have various stages varying from foundations to finishes.

Muck away update

• We are currently moving some spoil piles off site, This is a Heavy Plant operation which needs to be carried out for Planning and should complete 1st tranche late May.

- Important dates: first completions are anticipated for June 2024*
- Show homes and the marketing suite are now open to the public
- The roads and footpaths to the site will be completed in line with the construction site progress
- We are anticipating site completion in September 2025*

- Gateway will be providing general repairs and maintenance to landscaped areas as well as private roads and car park areas.

Ecology

- Newt fencing remains in place and will be removed in sections in agreement with the ecologists as construction progresses
- Hedgehog highways are being installed throughout the development
