Keeping you updated

We want to provide you with an update on the development and what you can expect from us over the coming months.

Overview

This new-build development offers a choice of quality 3 and 4 bedroom homes in a beautiful countryside setting. Twigworth Green is a consortium site comprising of 725 homes built by Bovis Homes, Linden Homes and Bloor Homes.

In addition, this exciting new community will provide:

- Local shop, café and bakery
- Children's play area, sports pavilion and pitches
- Proposed primary school
- Balancing ponds and countryside walks
- Energy efficient homes with the introduction of solar panels and waste-water heat recovery systems to selected homes

Site activity

- Work will be starting on the sports pitches and pavilion this summer.
- Tewkesbury Borough Council is responsible for the allocation of land for the proposed primary school.
- Phase 1 homes are being handed over to managing agent Gateway Property Management Limited. Residents on Phase 1 will be contacted by the managing agent.

Timeline

- We have now released homes on Phase 3 of the development.
- Sales centre and show homes are open daily from 10am to 5pm. We have a Maple and an Aspen show home available to view.
- The main play park is due to open this summer and you can now explore the countryside walks which are available from the ecology zone in the south part of the development.
- Work on the sports pitches and pavilion/changing facilities is planned to start shortly and they should be ready to use in Autumn 2025.
- We continue progress implementing infrastructure such as roads and footpaths endeavouring to provide access to the wider development features as quickly and as safely as possible.

Managing agent

 will look after the public
 spaces across your
 development.
- The estimated handover to the managing agent is 2026.

Ecology

- We are working with the British Hedgehog
 Preservation Society (BHPS) to install
 Hedgehog highways, which are hedgehog
 sized holes that are created at ground level in
 fencing and other barriers to allow access
 between selected gardens and wilder areas.
 Each highway enables hedgehogs to roam
 freely and forage for food.
- Bird and bat boxes will be erected on the trees alongside Hatherley Brook and we will be creating log piles to provide shelter for local wildlife.
