We wanted to provide you with an update on the development and what you can expect from us over the coming months.

Overview

Overview of what's being built. In addition, the development will provide:

- The site is comprised of 80 units with 32 affordable homes.
- Car park completed for Hamstreet Primary School.
- Football pitch still currently under construction.
- Attenuation basin completed and protection fencing installed.

Site activity

- Construction works still ongoing.
- Work on the football pitches has commenced
- Work on the Woodland school has commenced
- Car park for Hamstreet Primary school has been handed over

Specific item –

- Working with Hamstreet School to hold a construction educational week in April

Timeline

- Planning reference 21/00524/AS
- We welcomed our first residents in June 2023
- The show home date and marketing suite opened in April 2023
- Play equipment installed and finishing touches being done. We hope to open to the public in April 2024.
- The Woodland school is due to open Autumn 2024
- Construction on site is due to finish Winter 2024
