Timeline

- As of Saturday 26th March, our sales centre will be open Thursday to Monday 10am 5pm. Speak to

- We are constructing two stunning show homes. The Spruce II which is a detached 3-bed home and The Aspen which is a detached 4-bed home. The show homes are due to open Summer 2025.
- Energy efficient 3 and 4 bedroom homes are now for sale, with first occupations due to take place in Autumn 2025.
