Outside spaces to enjoy

At Bovis Homes we appreciate the importance of having outdoor space close by, and play areas for children to enjoy. At Partridge Walk you will find a designated Public Open Space (POS) area, along with footpaths and allotments that serve the whole development.

Attenuation ponds

A fairly common feature around new residential developments, attenuation ponds are an important element in the collection and management of rainwater for irrigation and to prevent flooding. At Partridge Walk you will find an attenuation basin has been created, as part of the overall drainage strategy.
