We wanted to provide you with an update on the development and what you can expect from us over the coming months.

Overview

- A total of 201 homes to include private and affordable homes of mixed tenure
- There are no play areas on our phase of development, however they are on the wider development. These are to be installed by other develops
- Attenuation basin is in and operational, and was completed by other developers
- Solar panels) for all homes that fall under the 2021 building regulations (These are homes that were started after June 2023
- The access into the development from the A5, the works being completed by the consortium not Vistry, are nearing completion which has much improved and formalised the access into the development

Site activity

- Infrastructure (roads and sewers) are in for the whole development
- We are preparing to decamp the main build compound to allow for the foundations to be released, there are only 15 plots left to dig!

Footpath

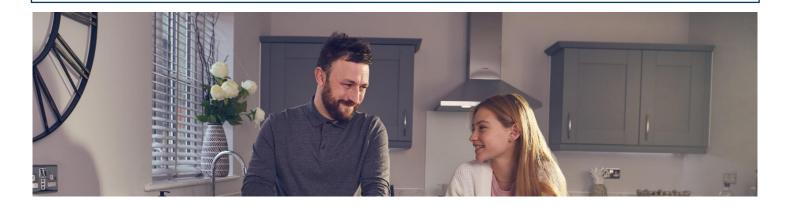
Footpath into PH2 is partially constructed and continually being built as plot works progress
