Summary of what's being built:

- 88 Homes, 33 of which are affordable
- Attenuation basin
- Photovoltaic panels and EV charging
- New sub station
- New pumping station

Site activity

- 48 homes currently in construction, 22 of which are affordable homes
- Moving towards our first completions due June 2024*
- Of the homes currently under construction we have various stages varying from foundations to finishes.

Drainage update

 We are working closely with Bellway Homes to ensure all drainage such as foul and storm water are connected and complete into the main lines. This is expected to be completed within the next few months*

Ecology

- Newt fencing remains in place and will be removed in sections in agreement with the ecologists as construction progresses
